STALL COMPETITION GUIDELINES **BEEF, LAMB, HORSE, RABBIT, GOAT, CAVY, DOG**

Stall cards can be of a unique construction but must be hung sturdily.

1. No streamers or any other waving obstacles, such as balloons, may be used which may frighten or distract the animals.
2. No flammable substance may be used.
3. Any excessive decorations will not be considered in the stall competition. They will be for general appearance of the 4-H Club to the general public.
4. Any decoration should not interfere with the sight of any other clubs or with the sight of any animals within the club itself.
5. No decorations shall exceed 8" in height and/or beyond the allotted stall premises of a club (including sign).
6. Greenery will be permitted on a manageable basis.
7. The committee reserves the right to manage any excessive decorations.
8. The committee will charge \$100.00 to any club leaving an excess of debris and/or garbage.
9. Bad conduct of any member during the BC Agricultural Expo can result in loss of this competition.
10. Beef, Sheep and Horse only compete in the competition if they meet the required aggregate number of members in the division.
11. Rabbit and Cavy will be judged together.
12. All other divisions will be judged separately.
13. It is the responsibility of the 4H exhibitor to maintain the stall areas.
14. The stall competition will start at 8 AM on the THURSDAY of BC Ag Expo and will continue through to 2 PM on the SATURDAY of BC Ag Expo.
15. Stalls to be judged by each Club (Leader or Parent) once during the duration of the weekend, with the date and whether they need to judge AM (8am-12pm) or PM (2pm-6-pm) indicated on each individual judging card. The cards are to be handed into the office daily in the "Stall Competition" drop box, with no cards submitted past 230 on Saturday.
16. You do not judge your own club.

17. If your club does not participate, they will be docked the highest score they receive over the weekend.
18. Judging cards will be put in the leader packages.

SCORING CRITERIA

APPEARANCE (20pts)

- Club & Project signage
- Equipment put away
- Neat & tidy
- Originality in design

SAFETY (10pts)

- First Aid Kit
- Safety & Contact Information

ANIMAL WELFARE (15pts)

- Clean Water
- Animals stalled safely
- Project & Pens/Stalls Clean
