

4-H Horse Division Show & Fitting Information

1. One entry per club. Contestants must be named on entry form.
2. Contestants will not be allowed to leave the area once the competition starts.
3. Any washing, blow drying or clipping must be done prior to the commencement of the class.
4. Contestants must wear lot numbers at all times during the class as this is the only means of identification the Judge will have.
5. Each contestant is to have a Junior member as their handler in the Show and Fitting class. If a club does not have a Junior member, a Senior member will then be permitted to be the handler.
6. Only grooming and show equipment allowed in the ring. No clippers, chutes, blow dryers, electric shears, etc.
7. If the person named first on the club entry cannot participate, the alternate person may do it, provided the office is notified in writing ten (10) days prior to BC Ag Expo.
8. It is **mandatory** for every club entered in BC Ag Expo to enter one team in their division's Show & Fitting provided they have an eligible member, and these Show & Fitting points will count towards Club Aggregate points.
9. **THE SENIOR MEMBER'S HORSE HAS TO BE USED FOR THE COMPETITION WITH NO SUBSTITUTIONS - NO EXCEPTIONS**
