Class Rules and Regs (in addition to general rules and regulations, and specific class rules (ie.Nichol, Sealin)

- 4-H Steer –Must have bill of sale.
 - 4-H Homegrown Market Steers only and must have been purchased from the home herd of the 4-H Member's parents or grandparents only.
- 4-H Heifer Must have bill of sale if being sold at auction and must be registered for sale at Office by noon Friday of the fair.
- 4-H Cow/Calf class will be assembled based on calf Date of Birth.
- Mitchell Family Best 4-H Calf Class open to all calves on 4-H cow-calf pairs. Shown separately from the cow.
- 4-H Young Beef as per Unit 2 of BC 4-H Project regulations Pub# 400 (born in calendar year, not eligible for market, feeder animal or heifer)
- 4-H Beef Carcass See 4-H and OPEN Beef Carcass Rules and Regulations. Must have bill of sale. The top 4 overall Beef and Lamb Carcasses will be displayed in the cooler at the BC Ag Expo and must be sold by auction. Unless otherwise specified, all Carcasses will be sold by auction. However, the BC Ag Expo Carcass Committee has the right to withhold a B Grade or a Dark Cutter Beef Carcass from the BC Ag Expo Livestock Auction.
- 4-H Commercial Female Class any 4-H commercial female (non-purebred).
- Fred Nichol Class please also complete and submit Fred Nichol Entry form. (B4)
- Sealin Creek Ranch Heifer Award please complete and submit separate entry form (B6). Open to all 4-H beef members exhibiting a female project at the current year's BC Ag Expo. The top aggregate member exhibiting a female project, with their aggregate points coming from a female project, will be awarded a purebred Black Angus heifer calf by Sealin Creek Ranch.
