‘BOUNDARY DASH’ RULES & REGULATIONS

1. The Boundary Dash is restricted to Members that have attended previous BC Ag Expo’s.
2. Club members who have won in a previous 4-H Event (Fred Nichol, Twemlow Event) are not eligible.
3. Qualifications for contestants are:
 - a. Be a member of a 4-H Club competing at the current year’ BC Ag Expo Fair
 - b. Must be a senior member (**14-18 YEARS OLD**) and have Junior Proficiency Certificate. Must be of a regularly organized 4-H Club attending BC Ag Expo the following year.
 - c. Must be able to feed and care for a beef/sheep/horse/goat/dog animal and have the necessary facilities and feed for proper care, feeding and training of animals if the money is used towards an animal project.
 - d. Must comply with all terms as stated on the “Entry Form” and must provide the BC Ag Expo Committee with the Minor’s Release form, duly signed and witnessed as required on the form.
 - e. Must have completed **one full year** in club work previous to this current year.
 - f. The money **MUST** be put towards your project and must be exhibited at the Fair the following year using a display format:

Create an educational display to be entered and judged in a separate class at BC Ag Expo (educational display board size). Criteria for display similar to Educational Display but messages to be directed towards;

What was \$ spent on and how the expenditure will help further 4-H learning?

What kinds of new learning opportunities have been undertaken with the \$.

- g. Event winners will insure a calf (if chosen) through their 4-H club and/or 4-H District.
- h. 4-H Members must provide the Event Committee with a Bill of Sale (animals) or receipt (photography, goat, dog, clothing, rabbit, horse tack) once they have used the sponsorship funds to purchase an item/animal.

4. Failure to comply with any of the above prescribed regulations will result in forfeiture of the sponsorship funds. The 4-H member will need to refund the full sponsorship amount to the Event Committee within 30 days.
5. Signed Entry Forms must be completed and emailed to secretary@bcagexpo.ca prior to **August 15th**. No applications will be considered that are not properly completed. Enter the class online at <https://bcagexpo.fairwire.com>
6. Successful contestants **MUST** write their sponsors (some have more than one sponsor) a “thank you” letter which should be done as soon as possible after the Fair.
7. **If the member is not able to attend the next year’s fair, the money must be returned to the fund for use the following year.**

Please read all Instructions. They will be strictly enforced.

Members must submit all three of the following. Only the digital marketing poster and essays will be marked.

- a. **A minimum 500 word essay (50% of total score) – upload as PDF1**
 - i. What does BC Ag Expo mean to you?
- b. **A digital marketing poster (50% of total score) – upload as PDF2**
 - i. Poster must be marketing one of your current year 4-H projects.
 - ii. Poster must be created by the member.
 - iii. Poster must be created using computer technology.
- c. **A video of you making a rope halter – upload as video**

Video must be 5 minutes or less.
