4-H & OPEN YOUTH LAMB CARCASS REGULATIONS 2020

- 1. One Entry per exhibitor. Entries are restricted to clubs / youth that have previously attended BC Ag Expo.
- 2. Open to both wethers and ewes.
- 3. All 4-H entries must be tagged as a 4-H project, and a project record book (market lamb) kept.
- 4. All livestock manifests for transporting to and from the fair should include the North Thompson Fall fair Premise #BC4469RH3.
- 5. Lambs to be shorn just prior to attending BC Ag Expo.
- 6. All entries will be slaughtered as arranged for by the BC Ag Expo Committee.
- 7. Each carcass will be appraised by officers of the Livestock Division for points allocated for carcass quality.
- 8. CARCASSES SOLD THROUGH ONLINE SALE and will be charged 3% commission.
- 9. All carcass lambs must be at the North Thompson Fall Fair grounds on Monday, September 21, 2020 between 2:00 PM and 3:00 PM for health inspection and tagging. BC AG Expo will transport to Rainer Custom Cutting.
- 10. 4-H Entry forms, accompanied by \$60, plus GST, must be received by August 15, 2020. Open Youth Entry forms, accompanied by \$60, plus GST, must be received by August 15, 2020. Enter online at https://bcagexpo.fairwire.com.
- 11. All entrants in this division are subject to the General Rules & Regulations of the BC Ag Expo, as well as the 4-H & OPEN Sheep Rules & Regulations.
- 12. A mandatory side profile photo of the live carcass lamb with the exhibitor, late in the feeding period, is required to be submitted by September 8th at https://bcagexpo.fairwire.com/ . This photo will be used for virtual show purposes and the on-line auction.

BC Agricultural Expo - SALE RULES

- 1. Carcasses will be sold by the dollar.
- 2. Three percent (3%) on the amount of the sale of each carcass sold will be retained by the BC Agricultural Exposition Society to assist in meeting online sale expenses.
- 3. Carcasses will be sold throughout the in order of placing.
