Class Rules and Regs (in addition to 4-H & Open Beef Regulations 2022, and specific class rules (ie. Futurity)

- Open Jackpot Market Steer -- must have bill of sale. Will be shown by weight.
- Open Jackpot Prospect Steer must be a steer calf born in the current calendar year. Will be shown by weight.
- Open Jackpot Heifer if selling, must have bill of sale and office must be notified of any female projects being sold no later than 12 Noon Friday of the Fair.
- Open Jackpot Cow/Calf classes will be assembled based on calf Date of Birth.
- **Open Youth Market Steer** must be aged 6-9 years old as of Friday of the Fair.
 - must have bill of sale. Will be shown by weight.
- Open Youth Prospect Steer must be a steer calf born in the current calendar year. Will be shown by weight

- must be aged 6-9 years old as of Friday of the Fair

- **Open Youth Heifer** must be aged 6-9 years old as of Friday of the Fair.
- Open Youth Cow-Calf must be aged 6-9 years old as of Friday of the Fair.

- classes will be assembled based on calf Date of Birth

- Open Beef Carcass See 4-H and OPEN Beef Carcass Rules and Regulations. Must have bill of sale. The top 4 overall Beef and Lamb Carcasses will be displayed in the cooler at BC Ag Expo. Unless otherwise specified by Carcass Committee, all Carcasses will be sold by auction. However, the BC Ag Expo Carcass Committee has the right to withhold a B Grade or a Dark Cutter Beef Carcass from the BC Ag Expo Livestock Auction.
- Please Note: All Beef Projects entered at BC Ag Expo must have a CCIA tag and be entered under that number ** BILL OF SALE FORMS ARE MANDATORY FOR MARKET PROJECTS ** (EVEN IF CALF IS FROM OWN HERD)
- All OPEN STEERS must be in the pens no later than 7 p.m., THURSDAY of the Expo. NO ENTRIES WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE BARN BEFORE 8 a.m. Thursday of the Expo.
- WEIGH-IN & Brand Inspection: See Beef Rules and Regs for revised 2019 Weigh In Procedure. All BEEF Projects must be Brand Inspected, have the CCIA # Confirmed and Project Weighed on the Thursday afternoon of the Expo in order to qualify for showing at the BC Ag Expo. All Open Youth Steers MUST be sold through the Auction.
