4-H RULES AND REGULATIONS – RABBIT DIVISION

1. 4-H Entries must be completed and returned to the BC Agricultural Exposition Society by the Club Leader, with entry fees, before June 30th, 2020. Entry fees are \$ 10 per project (plus GST of 0.50 for Total of \$10.50). Open Entries are accepted up until September 1st.
2. Only registered 4-H unit animals may be entered and shown in 4-H Classes.
3. 4-H Rabbits are housed in BC Ag Expo cages where possible. All open entries must provide their own cages.
4. All 4-H rabbits must be in the stall area by Thursday at 6:30 p.m. and remain in the barn until Sunday following the club presentations.
5. All animals must be healthy. Members must advise the Leader of any rabbit that is currently receiving medication. Complaints of sick animals will be investigated by two Leaders. A sick animal will be removed. This animal will not be considered as successfully shown for achievement.
6. Animals are to be treated with respect. Except in an emergency, animals are only to be handled by their owners or leaders. Members are responsible for providing their own supplies and for feeding and watering their own rabbits. Grooming must be done in the designated area. Care should be taken with blow dryers and other grooming equipment.
7. Members are responsible for fulfilling their stall duty when it is their shift. This includes:
 - Being well groomed and on time
 - Wearing club uniforms
 - Grooming animals and keeping animal cages clean
 - Making sure animals have water
 - Speaking to the public about the projects, yourself and your club
 - It is the member's responsibility if he or she can not work their stall duty shift to arrange for someone to replace them.
8. Members who are not presently on stall duty or are grooming and working with their animals must not interfere with those members who are working stall duty.
9. All cage cleaning will be done before 8:00 a.m. each morning.

10. It is the member's responsibility to appear in uniform and on time with their animals for competition.
11. MEMBERS ARE EXPECTED TO BEHAVE AT ALL TIMES IN A MANNER BEFITTING A 4-H MEMBER. DISREGARD OF CLUB OR BC AG EXPO RULES AND REGULATIONS WILL RESULT IN THE REMOVAL OF THE MEMBER AND THEIR UNIT(S) FROM THE EXPO.
12. All decisions on these rules shall be made in conference with the BC Ag Expo Grievance Committee and shall be considered final. These classes are for 4-H members only. All rabbits entered must be registered project animals.
13. All rabbits must be in the barn by 6:30 p.m., Thursday of the Expo. No animals to leave before Sunday at 2:00PM
