STALL COMPETITION GUIDELINES

BEEF, LAMB, HORSE, RABBIT, GOAT

PLEASE DO NOT JUDGE THE STALLS WHEN THE MEMBERS ARE SCHEDULED TO BE AWAY FROM THEIR STALLS (IE: JUDGING)

- 1. Stall cards can be of a unique construction, but must be hung sturdily.
- 2. No streamers or any other waving obstacles, such as balloons, may be used which may frighten or distract the animals.
- 3. No flammable substance may be used.
- 4. Any excessive decorations will not be considered in the stall competition. They will be for general appearance of the 4-H Club to the general public.
- 5. Any decoration should not interfere with the sight of any other clubs or with the sight of any animals within the club itself.
- 6. No decorations shall exceed 8" in height and/or beyond the allotted stall premises of a club (including sign).
- 7. Greenery will be permitted on a controlled basis.
- 8. The committee reserves the right to control any excessive decorations.
- 9. The committee will charge \$100.00 to any club leaving an excess of debris and/or garbage.
- 10. Bad conduct of any member during the BC Agricultural Expo can result in loss of this competition.
- 11. Any 4-H member found consuming alcoholic beverages on the premises will automatically disqualify his/her club from stall competition.
- 12. The stall competition will start at 8 AM on the SATURDAY of BC Ag Expo and will continue on a 24-hour basis (although the children are not required to be in attendance for that duration) through to 3 p.m. on the SUNDAY of BC Ag Expo.
- 13. Stalls to be checked by (2) judges 2 times per day and these points will be averaged for the Club's daily score.
- 14. Please refer to stall competition score card for distribution of points awarded.
