### **ENTRIES:**

1. Entry deadline is June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2020. No refunds of entries after deadline. All Leaders must enclose an address and contact name and phone number with entries – please specify your Club name.
2. Fees: Project Small Engines member \$10.00 per entry (plus 5% GST) GST# 77836 2723  
Cheque made out to BC Agricultural Exposition Society
3. Division Rules, Regulations & Scoring will follow the **BC 4-H Guidelines** for the Small Engines Projects.
4. 4-H Project entries in BC Agricultural Expo include:
  - Unit 1 Two-Stroke Engine (Class)
  - Unit 2 Four-Stroke Engine (Class)
  - Unit 3 Mastering Mechanics (Class)
  - Unit 4 Beyond Engines (Class)
  - Unit 5 Senior Management(Display)
  - Showmanship (Class)
5. Completed Small Engines Projects may be sold through the BC Ag Expo Livestock Auction on the Monday of the Expo at a 6% commission to the BC Agricultural Expo Society.  
Note for Buyers: **\*\* (Payable GST is applicable on the auction price) \*\***
6. Members must indicate on the Small Engines Entry Form if they wish to sell their Small Engines Project through the BC Ag Expo Livestock Auction. (Optional, but must be indicated prior to BC Ag Expo).
7. Age of Members: Junior - 9 to 11yrs    Intermediate - 12 to 14yrs    Senior - 15 to 19yrs  
(as of Dec 31<sup>st</sup> of previous year).

8. Additional Displays or Work Areas required for the division will need to be requested through the BC Ag Expo Committee/Secretary.
9. All projects may **ONLY** be started for showmanship or other approved reasons, **outside of ALL buildings AND in a designated area only.**
10. **Required Safety Rules must be followed and Safety Gear must be worn when starting any projects.** A leader or designated adult must be present whenever Small Engine Projects are started.
