LINCOLN RIFLE CLUB MULTIGUN DIVISION ORMSBY RANGE RULES - Rev. 01-2018

1. Range Commands

Know and obey all range commands. Shooters or visitors may be expelled from the range by a member of the Ormsby Range Staff for violating these rules.

2. Cold Range

The Ormsby Range is a "cold" range. Firearms cannot be loaded unless the shooter is under the supervision of a Range Officer in a shooting bay.

3. Muzzle control

Always keep muzzles pointed in a safe direction. You may be expelled from the range by a member of the Ormsby Range Staff if you break the "180 degree rule" or for allowing the muzzle to point at yourself or at another person.

4. Finger on trigger

Keep your finger off the trigger except when shooting. The shooter's finger must be outside the trigger guard unless they are actively engaging targets.

5. Holsters

Holsters must prevent access to, or activation of, the trigger of the handgun while holstered. Cross draw holsters are not allowed.

6. Handgun Ready Condition

Before holstering a loaded handgun, place it in the applicable "handgun ready" condition. For a single action self-loader, the primary safety must be applied. For double action self-loaders and revolvers, the hammer must be down.

7. Uncased handguns

Uncased handguns outside of the shooting bays or safe areas, must be unloaded, magazine removed and in a holster securely attached to a belt on their person, or bagged.

8. Uncased long guns

Uncased long guns outside of the shooting bays or safe areas, must be unloaded, magazine removed and carried reasonably vertical, with a chamber flag flag inserted. Allowing the muzzle to point at any person, with or without a chamber flag inserted, is a safety violation.

9. Under 18 years old

Shooters under 18 years of age must be under the supervision of a qualified adult, parent or guardian at all times.

10. Eye and hearing protection

Eye and hearing protection must be worn at all times by all individuals, including minors and visitors.

11. Impact of shots

All shots must impact the berm. Rifle targets may NOT be placed on a berm with a point of impact greater than 36 inches beyond the target. (You may lay a target against the berm)

12. Safe Tables / Areas

No handling of ammunition, dummy ammunition, loaded magazines of any type in the Safe Tables / Areas. You may have them on your person as long as you are not handling them at the Safe Table / Area. Any violation of this section shall be a mandatory match disqualification.

13. Clean-up / approved targets

Shooters are responsible for cleaning up all debris. Only props and targets approved by the MGD committee may be used at the Ormsby Range. Glass, appliances, computers, or flammable items are prohibited from being used as targets on the Ormsby Range.

14. Two people required

For safety reasons, at least two persons are required for "shots fired" on the Ormsby Range.

15. Minimum distances

Minimum distances for any metal target are specific for that firearm type: (Reference United Multi-gun League Rules ver. 1.3)

Handgun: 7 yards (21 feet) Rule 10.19

Rifle (any projectile > 1600 fps) 45 yards (135 feet) Rule 10.20

Birdshot 5 yards (15 feet) Rule 10.21

Add 3 feet if measuring to a fault line.

16. Prohibited ammunition

Armor piercing, steel jacketed, incendiary and/or tracer ammunition is strictly prohibited.

17. Serviceable firearms

All firearms must be serviceable and safe. Triggers and/or trigger shoes that extend beyond the width of the trigger guard are expressly prohibited.

18. Injuries

Immediately call 911. Report all injuries and catastrophic gun failures to the Ormsby Range Staff.

19. Unsportsmanlike conduct

Anyone may be expelled from the Ormsby facility for conduct the Range Staff deems to be unsportsmanlike or unsafe. This includes, but is not limited to, abusive or aggressive behavior toward the Range Staff or others, cheating, conduct deemed unsafe, suspected of being under the influence of alcohol or drugs. Notify the Range Staff immediately if you witness any unsafe condition on the Ormsby Range.

20. Off limits

All berms are off limits at all times, except when access is specifically permitted by a range officer.

21. Hold harmless waiver

Participants confirm and acknowledge that they have signed a Lincoln Rifle Club Hold Harmless Agreement within the past 12 months. A form must be signed if the participant's prior form is over one year old.
