FUTA 2019 represents the most elegant expression of CALCU's finest Cabernet Sauvignon.

Powerful, fresh, and deeply elegant. The nose reveals layers of black cherry, cassis, and graphite, intertwined with hints of tobacco, cedar, and spice. On the palate, it delivers great structure and finesse, with velvety, rounded tannins and a remarkable balance of ripe fruit, freshness, and complexity. The finish is long, refined, and persistent, making this wine ideal for ageing and highly praised by national and international critics alike.

Vinification & Terroir

FUTA is crafted exclusively from low-yielding plots in the Hurtado family's top vineyards in the Ramadilla Estate, nestled in the rolling hills of Marchigüe. These sites are defined by granitic soils rich in clay but low in organic matter, ideal for producing concentrated, structured wines. The nearby Pacific Ocean brings cooling breezes day and night, moderating temperatures during the growing season and preserving freshness.

Calcu Fotem 2019 was created to express the singular personality of Cabernet Sauvignon grown in the most coastal area of the Colchagua Valley. This wine stands out for its depth, structure, and power—capturing the full character and strength of its origin.

Sourced from vineyards planted on granitic soils rich in clay and cooled by steady Pacific breezes, Calcu Fotem delivers freshness, elegance, and identity. It opens with expressive aromas of crunchy black cherries and red plums, with subtle mineral and herbal notes in the background. On the palate, it shows great structure, body, and persistence—offering a bold, yet refined, experience with a long and layered finish.

Vinification & Terroir

The Ramadilla vineyards in Marchigüe are planted on rolling hills, where ocean breezes moderate the heat during the growing season, allowing the fruit to ripen slowly and evenly. The granitic-clay soils promote low yields and deliver wines of great elegance and power.

Winemaker's Selection 2019 represents CALCU's boldest and most expressive blend, crafted to highlight the unique character of each varietal from Marchigüe.

The wine opens with intense aromas of fresh blackberries, plum jam, sweet spices, and subtle cedar, followed by hints of vanilla, clove, and wild herbs. On the palate, it is juicy, smooth, and well-rounded, with elegant, polished tannins, generous body, and a long, persistent finish. A balanced and vibrant wine with remarkable drinkability and finesse.

Vinification & Terroir

Each year, CALCU Winemaker's Selection is crafted as a unique blend, designed to showcase the identity, elegance, and vitality of each varietal in perfect harmony.

The vineyards are located on rolling hills in the Marchigüe area, where ocean breezes from the Pacific cool the vines during the afternoon and night, preserving freshness and contributing to a longer ripening season. The granitic soils, with high clay content and low organic matter, result in naturally low yields and concentrated fruit.

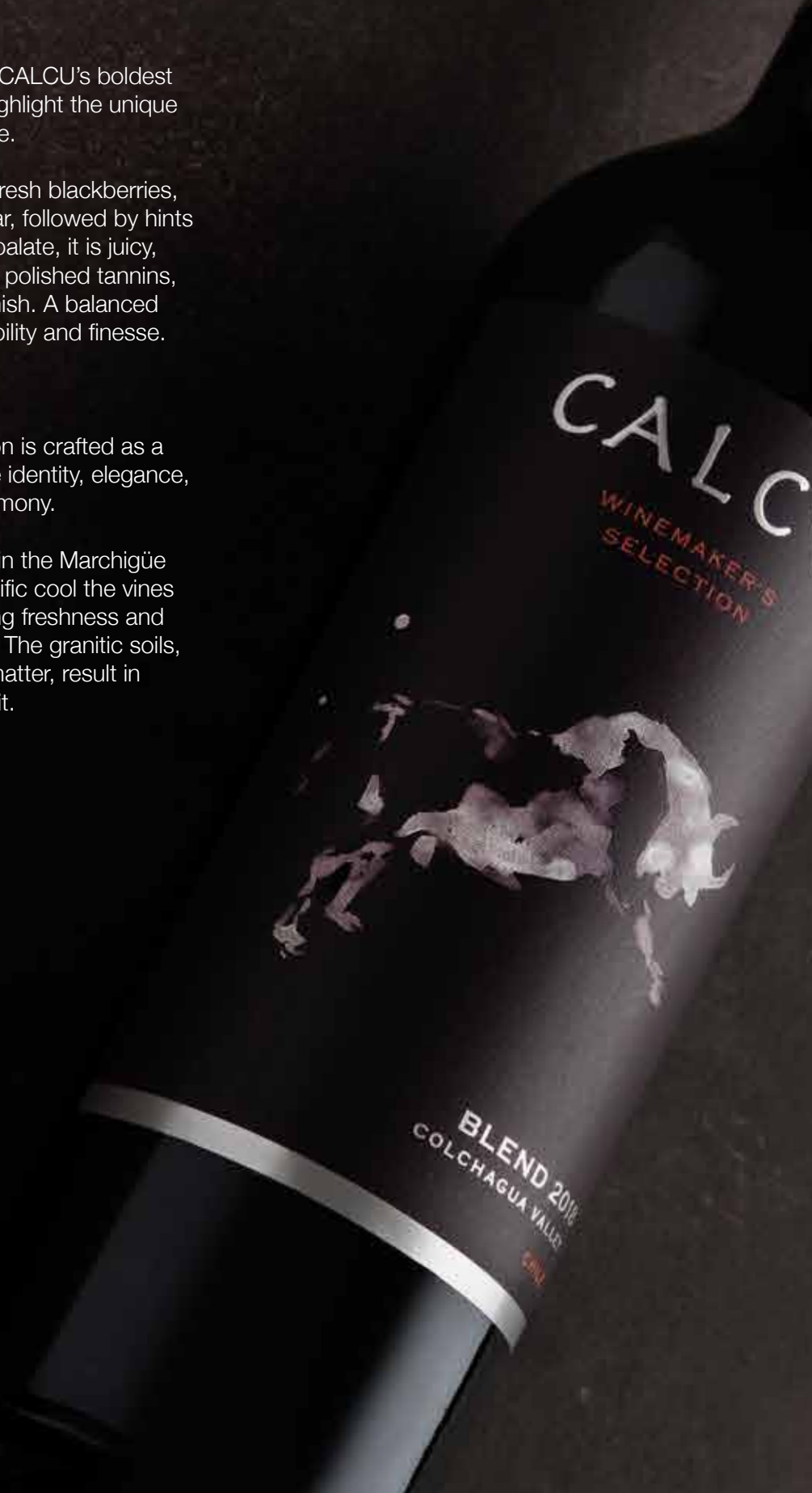

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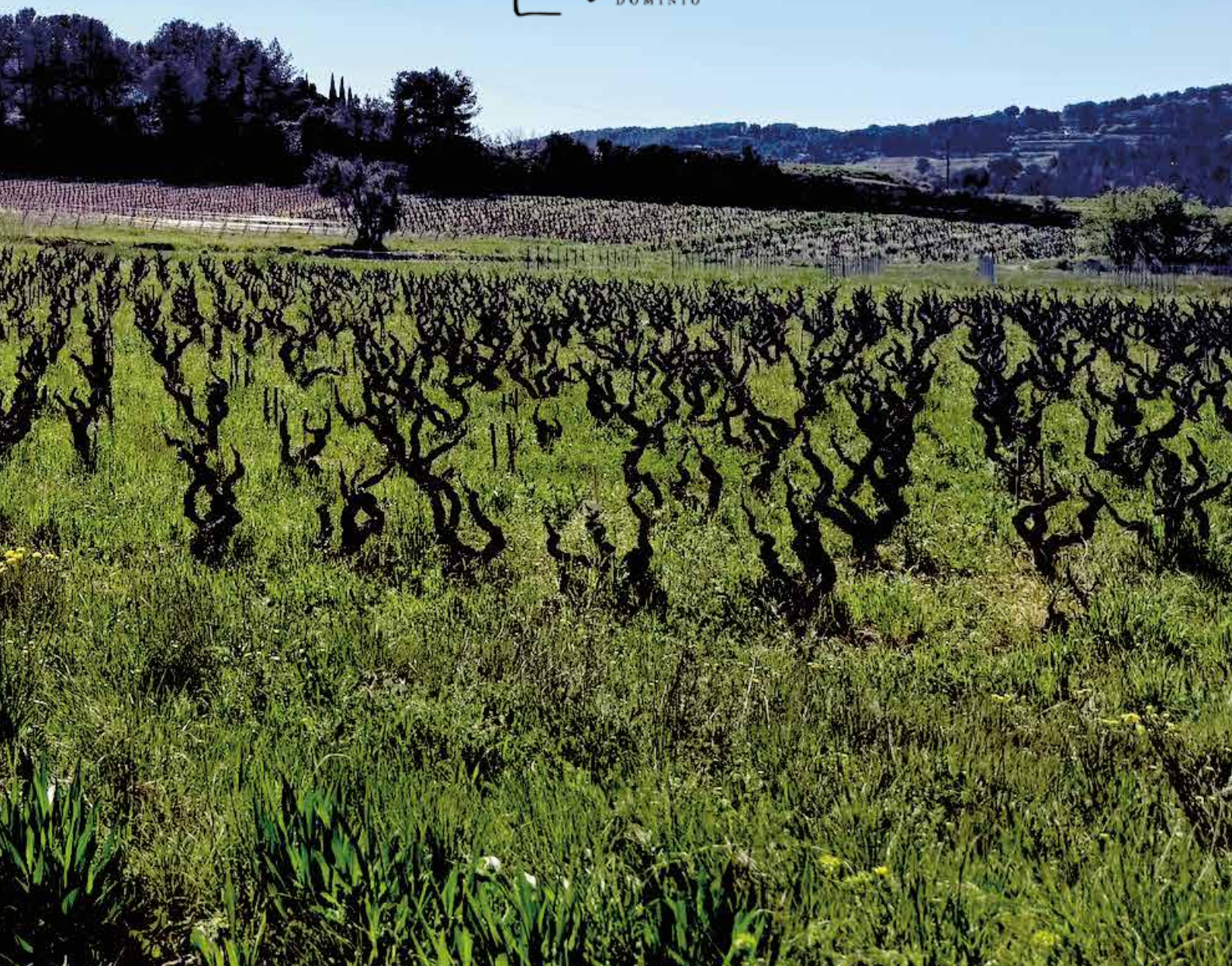

With an intense purple hue, this wine presents an expressive nose of sweet spices like vanilla and cinnamon, with earthy notes of forest floor. The palate bursts with ripe red and black fruits—plum, prune, and blackberry. Well-structured, it features smooth grape tannins, slightly astringent oak tannins, and balanced acidity. The oak adds complexity, leading to a long, pleasantly dry finish.
