1 TO ALL PARTIES AND THEIR COUNSEL OF RECORD:

2 Plaintiffs CHARLES LAIZURE and BENJAMIN BRAVO's Unopposed Motion for
3 Conditional Certification of Settlement Class and Preliminary Approval of Good Faith Determination
4 of Class Action Settlement, in the above-captioned matter, came on for hearing before this Court on
5 July 24, 2025 at 8:30 a.m. Sullivan & Yaeckel Law Group, APC and Capstone Law APC appeared on
6 behalf of Plaintiffs and the Class; Sagaser, Watkins and Wieland, PC, appeared on behalf of
7 Defendant. On good cause shown, and pursuant to the authority of California statutory and case law,
8 this Court finds that the settlement between Plaintiff and Defendant was made in good faith pursuant
9 to California Rules of Court, rules 3.769 and 3.770. Accordingly, this Court rules as follows:

10 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

- 11 1. Plaintiff's Unopposed Motion for Preliminary Approval of the Class Action Settlement is
12 hereby granted.
- 13 2. Specifically, the Court preliminarily orders as follows:
 - 14 a. Conditionally certifying the following class, which is subject to the Settlement:
15 all persons who worked for Defendant as non-exempt, hourly employees in the State
16 of California at any time between November 8, 2018 through February 28, 2025.
 - 17 b. Appointing CHARLES LAIZURE and BENJAMIN BRAVO.
 - 18 c. Appointing Sullivan & Yaeckel Law Group, APC and Capstone Law APC as Class
19 Counsel.
 - 20 d. Approving as to form and content the proposed Notice of Class Action Settlement.
 - 21 e. Appointing CAC Services, LLC ("CAC") to act as the Settlement Administrator. CAC
22 is directed to issue—via first-class United States mail—the Notice of Proposed Class
23 Action Settlement to the proposed Class Members, as specified in the Joint Stipulation
24 and Settlement of Class Action.
 - 25 f. The settlement class members are provided 45 -days from dissemination of the notice
26 to submit a dispute, object, or opt out of the proposed class action settlement.
 - 27 g. The Settlement is preliminarily approved subject only to the objections of Class
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Members and final review by the Court.

h. Class Counsel's request for Attorneys' Fees and Costs up to an amount of \$108,333.00 and up to \$15,000.00 in costs, is preliminarily approved, subject to the final review of the Court.

i. The Class Representative enhancement award of \$10,000 to Plaintiff Benjamin Bravo, and \$5,000 to Plaintiff Charles Laizure in consideration for serving as Class Representative is preliminarily approved, subject to final review of the Court.

3. The Court will hold a hearing on Plaintiff's Request for: **(1)** Final Approval of the Settlement; **(2)** Class Representative Enhancement Awards; and **(3)** Attorneys' Fees and Costs, on July 24, 2025 at 8:30 a.m. in department 44.
