



STATE OFFICE



Not later than the date of the first petition signature on a nomination petition, a person who may be a candidate for office pursuant to this section shall file a statement of interest with the appropriate filing officer for that office. The statement of interest shall contain the name of the person, the political party, if any, and the name of the office that may be sought. Any nomination petition signatures collected before the date the statement of interest is filed are invalid and subject to challenge. A.R.S. § 16-311(H); A.R.S. § 16-341(I).

- √ 25 years of age or older at the time of filing nomination papers
- ✓ Qualified registered voter of the City of Casa Grande at the time of filing nomination papers
- ✓ Resident of the City of Casa Grande for three years next preceding the date of the election
- ✓ Able to speak, write and read the English language
- ✓ A person convicted of a felony cannot serve as a Mayor until civil rights have been restored
- ✓ City employees are not eligible to stand for election or serve as Mayor
- ✓ Hold no other public office that may be in conflict with the Mayor position



Qualifications to run for Council Member

- √ 21 years of age or older at the time of filing nomination papers
- ✓ Qualified registered voter of the City of Casa Grande at the time of filing nomination papers
- ✓ Resident of the City of Casa Grande for three years next preceding the date of the election
- ✓ Able to speak, write and read the English language
- ✓ A person convicted of a felony cannot serve as a Council Member until civil rights have been restored
- ✓ City employees are not eligible to stand for election or serve as a Council Member
- ✓ Hold no other public office that may be in conflict with the Council Member position

Nomination Petitions – E-Qual

- Candidates running for the Casa Grande City Council (Mayoral or Council Member) may collect 100% of their required nomination petition signatures through the E-Qual system.
 - Online platform provided by the Arizona Secretary of State's office to allow candidates to collect eligible voter signatures on petitions electronically.
- Online Petition Portal allows candidates to create and manage their online nomination petitions.
 - Local candidates (Casa Grande) must use the Arizona Online Petition Portal for local offices. Candidates CANNOT use the regular Arizona Candidate Portal. Use of this system is authorized by Arizona Revised Statutes 16-317(A).

POLITICAL AND CAMPAIGN SIGN PLACEMENT

Determining Majority Vote – Casa Grande

Elected at the Primary

Any candidate who shall receive a majority of all the votes cast at such election shall be declared elected to the office for which he or she is a candidate, and no further election shall be held as to said candidate.

EXAMPLE

Candidate A - 500

Candidate B - 200

Candidate C – 300

Candidate D – 444

Total of Votes = 1,444

Divided the total by the number of seats to be filled, three (3) = 1444/3=481.33, Divide by two/or 50% = 241
