

What are the responsibilities of a Precinct Committeeperson?

As a Precinct Committeeperson (PC) you are the representative of the Democratic Party in your neighborhood. The people in your neighborhood are your constituents. You are their eyes, ears and voice within the party and state. The PC's job is to motivate, educate, inspire, and inform fellow Democrats in your precinct.

A PC's main focus is to get Democrats elected! We do that in several ways:

- Reaching out to your constituents. Covid-safe ways currently in use are via personal letter writing, postcards and telephone calls.

- Registering voters
- Adding voters to the Permanent Early Voter List (PEVL)

- Participating in "Get Out the Vote" efforts via text, phone calls, postcards and mailers, once the ballots have been sent to voters.

Most PCs attend regularly scheduled meetings of their local Democratic Club and LD meetings to actively participate and stay informed. PC Training is available.

By becoming a PC you will get to know your community better, engage with Democrats in your area, and connect with people who have similar values.

Becoming a PC is a grassroots political action which makes the party stronger - so please join us!
