**Entry Fees:** **Showmanship:** \$5.00 (member) \$7.00 (non-member)  
**Youth Show:** \$7.00 per goat, per class (member) \$9.00 per goat, per class (non-member)  
**Open Shows:** Members: \$10.00 per goat, per class, per show  
Non-Members: \$12.00 per goat, per class, per show

**Supplies:** Bermuda hay for bedding will be available for purchase. There will be a food vendor on site.

**Uniforms:** All 4H, FFA, or Grange members are to wear proper uniforms during the youth show only. If not affiliated, independent showman must wear blue jeans and collared shirt.

**Pen Fees:** \$10.00 per pen. Pens are 4 x 8. No bedding is provided, but Bermuda hay will be available for purchase. Pens will be assigned and marked for your convenience. Pen cleaning will be available for \$10.00/pen.

**Bring tarps/covers and/or plastic netting for baby goats as they can get out of pens.**



**Prospect Wether Class:** The purpose of the class is for exhibitors to show bucklings that are obviously going to be wethers, but have chosen not to castrate them at an early age. This class will be the first wether class judged at each show. However, they will not compete for Best Wether and Reserve Best Wether.

**Master Champion:** The Master Champion competition will be offered at the beginning of the Wether, Doe & Buck Shows. There must be three PGCH does/bucks for each competition. If you enter your animal and then are unable to bring it, please contact the Show Chair immediately so they can contact other owners in the event the show will not meet the required number. Please register your MCH in the show program. There are no entry fees for Master Champion classes.

**Health Check:** Only healthy animals allowed on fairgrounds. Animals with obvious signs of illness (runny noses, eyes, cough) or parasites (scratching or diarrhea) will be requested to leave. No refund on entry fees.

**N.P.G.A. RULES TO GOVERN:** N.P.G.A. SANCTIONED. Only animals with original registration papers or registration papers with transfers less than ninety (90) days will be allowed to show. See class list for more info. ***Original Registration Papers Need to Be Present At The Show***

**Awards:** NPGA Rosette Ribbons are awarded to all Champions. Additional prizes will be awarded as well.

**Open Show High Point:** This is an opportunity to earn points all year with your wethers, does, and bucks. Pay one time entry fee/goat and designate goat on additional entry form. Prizes will be awarded at the first show of the next year. Points will be calculated after every show and posted on the website. Can enter additional goats throughout the year.

How points are calculated:

1st Place:	5 points
2nd Place:	4 points
3rd Place:	3 points
4th Place:	2 points
5th Place:	1 point
