**Entry Fees:** **Showmanship:** \$5.00  
**Youth Show:** \$7.00 per goat, per class, per show  
**Open Shows:** Members: \$10.00 per goat, per class, per show  
Non-Members: \$12.00 per goat, per class, per show

**Supplies:** Bermuda Hay will be available for purchase. There will be a food vendor on site.

**Uniforms:** All 4H, FFA, or Grange members are to wear proper uniforms during the youth show only. If not affiliated, independent showman must wear blue jeans and collared shirt.

**Pen Fees:** \$10.00 per pen. Pens are 4 x 8. No bedding is provided, but grass hay will be available for purchase. Pens will be assigned and marked for your convenience. **\*\*We will have pen cleaning for \$10/pen or you will need to clean your own pen.**

***Bring tarps/covers and/or plastic netting for baby goats as they can get out of pens.***

**Prospect Wether Class:** The purpose of the class is for exhibitors to show bucklings that are obviously going to be wethers, but have chosen not to castrate them at an early age. This class will be the first wether class judged at each show. However, they will not compete for Best Wether and Reserve Best Wether.

**Master Wether Class:** You may enter this class if your wether has reached Platinum status with 12 wins. Must have two wethers entered to be able to offer this class.

**Master Champion:** The Master Champion competition will be offered at the beginning of the Doe & Buck Open Shows. The Master Wether show will be held at the beginning of the Open Shows & Youth Show. There must be three PGCH does/bucks for each competition and two wethers for the Master Wether classes. If you enter your animal and then are unable to bring it, please contact the Show Chair immediately so they can contact other owners in the event the show will not meet the required number.

**Health Check:** Only healthy animals allowed on fairgrounds. Animals with obvious signs of illness (runny noses, eyes, cough) or parasites (scratching or diarrhea) will be requested to leave. No refund on entry fees.

**N.P.G.A. RULES TO GOVERN:** N.P.G.A. SANCTIONED. Only animals with original registration papers or registration papers with transfers less than ninety (90) days will be allowed to show. ***Original Registration Papers Need to Be Present At The Show***

**Silent Auction:** There will be Silent Auctions during the shows with all proceeds going to SPGA. Any donations will be greatly appreciated. Please tape your name or business card to your donations so we know who to thank!

**Awards:** Ribbons are awarded for 1<sup>st</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> places in the Youth Show. NPGA Rosette Ribbons are awarded to all Champions. Additional prizes will be awarded as well.

**Meals:** There will be a food vendor with (breakfast, lunch & dinner) and drinks for sale.

**Open Show High Point:** This is an opportunity to earn points all year with your wethers, does, and bucks. Pay one time entry fee/goat per year and designate goat on additional entry form. Prizes will be awarded at the first show of the next year. Points will be calculated after every show and posted on the website. Can enter additional goats throughout the year.

How points are calculated:

1st Place:	5 points
2nd Place:	4 points
3rd Place:	3 points
4th Place:	2 points
5th Place:	1 point
