Entry Fees: **Showmanship:** \$5.00
 Youth Show: \$7.00 per goat, per class, per show
 Open Shows: \$10.00 per goat, per class, per show

LATE Entry Fees: *On-time entries close on June 6th. Late fees apply June 7th. Add \$3.00 for every goat/class/show and showman.* Showmanship: \$8.00; Youth Show: \$10.00; Open Show: \$13.00. You will need to request late entries. The show chair will then open the entries for you on Pygmy.show. Please include late fees with your payment.

Supplies: Evans Feed will have a booth on-site with Bermuda Hay & shavings for bedding, along with alfalfa hay, grain & livestock supplies available for purchase.

Uniforms: All 4H, FFA, or Grange members are to wear proper uniforms during the youth show only. If not affiliated, independent showman must wear blue jeans and collared shirt.

Pen Fees: \$10.00 per pen. Pens are 4 x 8. No bedding is provided, but Bermuda hay & shavings will be available for purchase. Pens will be assigned and marked for your convenience.

Bring tarps/covers and/or plastic netting for baby goats as they can get out of pens.

Prospect Wether Class: The purpose of the class is for exhibitors to show bucklings that are obviously going to be wethers, but have chosen not to castrate them at an early age. This class will be the first wether class judged at each show. However, they will not compete for Best Wether and Reserve Best Wether.

Sterling Wether Class: You may enter this class if your wether has reached Platinum status with 12 wins. Must have two wethers entered to be able to offer this class.

Master Champion: The Master Champion competition will be offered at the beginning of the Doe & Buck Open Shows. There must be three PGCH does/bucks for each competition. If you enter your animal and then are unable to bring it, please contact the Show Chair immediately so they can contact other owners in the event the show will not meet the required number.

Health Check: Only healthy animals allowed on fairgrounds. Animals with obvious signs of illness (runny noses, eyes, cough) or parasites (scratching or diarrhea) will be requested to leave. No refund on entry fees.

N.P.G.A. RULES TO GOVERN: N.P.G.A. SANCTIONED. Only animals with original registration papers or registration papers with transfers less than ninety (90) days will be allowed to show.
