<b>ATTENDED FUNERAL (funeral director's charges only)</b>	
This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service or the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.	<b>£1945</b>
Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements	<b>£545</b>
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care	<b>£185</b>
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at the funeral director's premises.	<b>£450</b>
Providing a suitable coffin – this will be made from (Oak effect veneer)	<b>£495</b>
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director	<b>£1</b>
At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle	<b>£269</b>
<b>UNATTENDED FUNERAL</b>	
This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.	
<b>Burial (funeral director's charges only)</b>	<b>£1065</b>
<b>Cremation (funeral director's charges plus the cremation fee) <sup>2</sup></b>	<b>£1395</b>
<b>FEES YOU MUST PAY</b>	
For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the <b>burial fee</b> . <sup>1</sup> In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is: For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.	<b>£825</b>
For an Attended cremation funeral, the <b>cremation fee</b> . <sup>2</sup> In this local area, the typical cost of a cremation for local residents is:	<b>£1025</b>

<b>ADDITIONAL FUNERAL DIRECTOR PRODUCTS AND SERVICES</b>	
This funeral director may be able to supply a range of optional, additional products and services, or to arrange (on your behalf) for a third party to supply them. Examples include:

<sup>1</sup> This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

<sup>2</sup> In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.
