PASTOR'S CORNER

Living from the Bread of Life Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ Corpus Christi

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This Sunday, the Church celebrates the beautiful Solemnity of Corpus Christi, the Most Holy Body and Blood of Our Lord Jesus Christ. It is a day when we pause to give thanks for one of the greatest gifts Jesus has left us: The Holy Eucharist.

At every Mass, we hear the words of Jesus: "This is my Body... This is my Blood." These are not merely symbolic words. As Catholics, we believe that Jesus is truly present in the Eucharist—Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity. Every time we come to Mass, we encounter not simply a reminder of Jesus, but Jesus himself.

In a world where many people feel lonely, forgotten, or hungry for meaning, Christ continues to feed his people. He comes to us as the Bread of Life, strengthening us in our struggles, comforting us in our sorrows, and nourishing us for our journey of faith.

As we celebrate Corpus Christi, let us renew our love for the Eucharist. Let us come to Mass with grateful hearts, spend time in prayer before the Blessed Sacrament, and recognize Christ not only on the altar but also in our neighbors, especially those who are most in need.

May our reverence for the Eucharist deepen our faith, strengthen our families, and inspire us to become living witnesses of Christ's love.

May the Body and Blood of Christ lead us safely on our earthly journey and bring us one day to the eternal banquet of heaven.
