What are the 5 liturgical seasons?

We begin the Liturgical Year on the First Sunday of Advent then move to Christmas, Ordinary Time, Lent, Triduum or Three Days, Easter, Pentecost and Ordinary Time again, finishing with the feast of Christ the King.

What are the 5 liturgical colors?

There are five basic liturgical colors:

Blue, White, Green, Purple, and Red.

- Advent – Blue. ...
- Christmas and Easter – White. ...
- Epiphany and Pentecost (Ordinary Time) – Green. ...
- Lent – Purple. ...
- Holy Week and Pentecost Sunday – Red. ...
- Good Friday – Black.
