

Irvington Grade School 2021-22 Back to School Plan

- School will be in session everyday: 8:00 - 3:10
 - Exception: Every Wednesday will be a 2:00 dismissal.
- The CDC/IDPH/ISBE recommend masks be worn by those who are unvaccinated. They also recognize local control during Phase 5 as stated:
"Together with local public health officials, school administrators should consider multiple factors when they make decisions about implementing layered prevention strategies against COVID-19. Since schools typically serve their surrounding communities, decisions should be based on the school population, families, and students served, as well as their communities."
- Based on the current conditions in our community, we will begin with a **mask recommendation for all unvaccinated people**. We will continue to monitor the health and wellbeing of our students and staff and adjust accordingly if needed. Everyone should be prepared to wear masks if our local metrics warrant that need.
- We will continue to request parents and visitors refrain from entering the school building during the school day.
- The district will be prepared to adjust educational and athletic programming as necessary throughout the year.
- The CDC/IDPH/ISBE **requires** all **bus passengers and drivers** to **wear a mask** while on the bus. The driver does not need to wear a mask if they are the only person on the bus.
- ANY student who is on Remote Learning must have a medical doctor's excuse. Remote Learning will only be offered to students under quarantine/isolation.
- Temperature checks and symptom screenings will continue to start the school year. Parents should keep their children home from school if they are sick or exhibiting symptoms.
- Good hand hygiene will be strongly encouraged and hand sanitizer will be readily available throughout the building.
- Social distancing will be maintained in all school areas to the best of our ability.
- The building will continue to undergo increased cleaning and sanitation daily.
- Athletic programs will run as normal with admissions charged at indoor, home sporting events. Masks will be recommended to unvaccinated guests.
- Field trips and fundraisers will resume as normal.
