

**STCPA PROVINCIAL FINALS
SHOW EVENT PACKAGE
JULY 12, 13 & 14, 2019**

All entries must be post marked by June 26, 2019.

Every penner must complete and submit his **own Summary Page!**

This page includes your entry fees and all other costs associated with the finals.

DO NOT SEND YOUR ENTRY FEES, JUST LEVY AND SPONSORS SO THEY CAN BE PUT IN THE FINALS BOOKLET.

RULES:

All penners must attend at least 3 Sanctioned shows in Saskatchewan & have paid the \$200.00 Levy. You may enter up to five (5) times in all classes. There is no cap on entries in the Open/Limited 8. Entries in the #5, #7, #10 can be 4 pick and one draw, or draw as many times to a max of 5. No draw in the Open/Limited 8. The deadline for all classes except the shoot-outs is June 26th. The shoot-out deadline is 7:00 am on Friday July 12th, 2019.

Youth Classes:

Sr. Youth – maximum of 3 teams - 1 pick team & 2 draw teams or 3 draw teams.

Jr. Youth class is all draw - maximum of 3 draw teams.

Youth classes will have 2 complete go rounds.

The Open, limited 8, #10, #7, #5 classes will have 2 go rounds with the top ½ of the teams coming back for the second go. Teams will carry their times forward in these classes. Payouts will be 1 place per 10 teams to a maximum of 6 placing. Top Ten will come back for Third go on Sunday, and times carry forward. Only these classes acquire points towards the Year End Awards. **Must pen cows in each go to advance.**

Shoot-Out Classes are an Open and #7. There is no limit on shoot-out entries.

Each penner may enter as often as they wish with a 1-rider change on each team. Competitors must enter a regular class in order to enter the Shoot-Out Classes. Top HALF come back for second go round on Saturday and the top HALF of these go to the finals on Sunday (to a maximum of ten teams), should there not be 10 teams with cattle down after the second go, only those teams that have penned cattle in all rounds will go to the TOP TEN in that class. On Sunday the order of go will be slowest to fastest. Shoot-Out classes are all sudden death every day (no times carried forward). Payouts will be 1 place per 10 teams to a maximum of 3 placings with a 90% payout. There is **NO POINTS** for these two classes.

NOTE: All teams in the Final top 10 on Sunday will receive their cattle number prior to each class.

In case of a Medical incapacity, a substitute rider may be approved by the STCPA Directors, prior to the 1st go. In this case the substitute rider will be same rating # or lower and will be chosen from riders who are not maxed out in that class. In the event that such a rider is not available, then a rider of equal # who is already entered to the limit may be approved by the STCPA Directors.

CAMPING FACILITIES:

There is no pre booking of campsites.

Limited Full Hook-Up sites available

Cost: \$35.00 per night, or Thursday-Sunday (\$105.00 + GST) This must be booked with the Ag. Society in advance of the finals. (306-931-7149) or you can park on the gravel by the outside warming arena at no charge(no sewer or water there. Horses cannot be in this area.

STALLS:

Cost: \$65.00 for Thursday-Sunday (3 nights). Your stalls must be completely cleaned out after the show. If they are not, you will be invoiced. STCPA will not be paying the fine. (no Straw-Shavings only)

Tack Stalls will be available at same rate as Box Stalls.

Please ensure that 4 people share a tack stall.

Haul-Ins:

Must tie to their trailer and ensure the area around your trailer is kept clean.

Cost \$30 – 3 days

Prairieland will not be doing any cleaning of stalls. Prairieland does not supply shavings.

PLEASE NOTE: If anyone camps or uses a stall more than 3 nights they may receive an invoice after the show for an additional \$35.00 per site and per stall.
