English	<p>The children will be working from the book <b>Oh Maya Gods!</b> By Maz Evans. Through this, they will work on a variety of different text types:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Diary entries;</li> <li>• Balanced argument;</li> <li>• Folklore story;</li> <li>• Character description;</li> <li>• Persuasive letter;</li> <li>• Playscripts.</li> </ul>
Maths	<p>This term the children will revisit and then extend their understanding of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Fractions – and the link to decimals and percentages;</li> <li>• Measures – area, perimeter and volume at Y6;</li> <li>• Ratio and Proportion;</li> <li>• Decimals – ordering, rounding and calculation;</li> <li>• Algebra;</li> <li>• Geometry – angles.</li> </ul>
Science	<p>In the first half of term, the children will be studying <b>Living Things</b>. They will broaden their knowledge of grouping vertebrates, invertebrates, plants and micro-organism by their shared characteristics. The children will learn about the work of Carl Linnaeus. They will make simple classification keys.</p> <p>In the second half of term, they be investigating <b>Circuits, batteries and switches</b>. The children will revisit electrical circuits. They will draw circuit diagrams and use models to explain current, resistance and voltage.</p>
Computing	<p>In the first half of term, the children will follow the Kapow unit <b>Programming: Intro to Python</b>. They will use the programming language 'Python' to create designs and art and learn how to create loops and nested loops to make their code more efficient.</p> <p>During the second half of term, the children will study the Kapow unit <b>Big Data</b>. They will develop their understanding of how networks and the Internet are able to share information and learning how big data can be used to design smart buildings</p>
Geography	The children will develop their understanding of the globe and different time zones.
History	This term the children are studying <b>The Mayans</b> . They will investigate features of their life style and links to other civilisations.
RE	This term, the children will be looking at both religious and non-religious world views to see if they are conflicting or complimentary. They will also investigate the Christian belief of the resurrection.
PSHE	<p>This term in PSHE, the children will be considering their <b>health and safety</b>, which will involve discussion about keeping safe online and also learning some basic first aid.</p> <p>They will also develop their understanding of <b>citizenship</b> investigating how they can value diversity, and also understand their rights and responsibilities.</p>
Art	The children will be working in a variety of media and linking their art work with the History topic of the Mayans.
PE	The children will be swimming, taking part in net and wall games and developing skills in dance.
MFL	The children will continue to develop their skills in French through the topic of 'My Best Day Ever.'
D & T	The children will carry out a food technology unit and will investigate and prepare a recipe from South America (linked to the History unit)
