English	<p>The children will be working on both narrative and non-fiction writing.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • They will write narratives in the genre of mystery/ suspense • Non-fiction – biographies
Maths	<p>This term the children will revisit and then extend their understanding of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fractions • Calculation <p>After SATs, Year 6 will carry out largely investigative work and some consolidation activities.</p> <p>Year 5 will develop their knowledge in the following areas:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Geometry – investigating 2D and 3D shapes; • Statistics – line graphs and tables; • Measures – converting measures;
Science	<p>In the first half of term, the children will be studying Light and Reflection. They will explore how light travels in straight lines and that this explains observations of shadows and reflection.</p> <p>In the second half of term, The children have an opportunity to revise the units from the year:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mixtures and separation. • Properties and changes. • Earth and space. • Circulation and health. • Light and reflection.
Computing	<p>In the first half of term, the children will continue to develop their understanding of spreadsheets.</p> <p>In the second half of term, they will develop their understanding of programming, using Scratch and eventually create their own game.</p>
Geography	The children will learn about rivers with a particular focus on The River Severn.
History	This term the children will develop their understanding of world history looking at The Sikh Empire . They will explore how it was founded and its legacy.
RE	This term, the children will study aspects of both Christianity and Humanism .
PSHE	This term in PSHE, the children will be developing their understanding of citizenship , and economic wellbeing . Towards the end of the summer term, the children will also be learning about puberty as part of their health education and Y6 will receive relationships and sex education.
Art	The children will be working in a variety of media and developing a 3D piece of art linked to their work in History.
PE	The children will be doing athletics, swimming, problem solving and rounders.
MFL	The children will continue to develop their skills in French through the topic of 'clothes.'
D & T	The children will develop their skills in electrical control by making an alarm to protect their artwork!
