Kara had recently moved back to Camas from Montana where she was attending college. She was 25 years old and was very concerned that having a baby was going to ruin her plans of going back to school. She was on the fence about how she would be able to work, go to school, and pay for childcare.

During her visit to Pathways, Kara received an ultrasound where she was able to meet her baby. However, despite the conversation with her Client Advocate, and her ultrasound, when Kara left our clinic that day she was still undecided about how to proceed with her pregnancy.

Our staff made several attempts to follow up with Kara, but we were never able to reach her. Our hearts broke for this young lady as we were left to assume that her lack of response was because she had decided to abort her baby.

However, in February of 2017 all of that changed when Kara once again walked through the doors at Pathways. She came in to thank us for all the support that she received on her previous visit to Pathways.

Kara shared with us that she had chosen life for her child and that she now has a beautiful baby boy. She also wanted us to know that because of Pathways she is "madly in love with her son Christopher".

Kara is proof that if we are faithful to plant seeds of love and hope, God can take care of the rest.

## Targeted Attacks Against CPC's

In recent years, Crisis Pregnancy Centers (CPC's) have come under attack by several "Pro-Choice" organizations. Many of us typically think of the larger organizations like Planned Parenthood and NARAL, but a whole new generation of smaller "Pro-Choice" organizations have sprung up in the last few years.

Several of these newer organizations have banded together in an effort to shut down CPC's across the nation. They claim that CPC's are "fake clinics" who mislead the women who come to them with misinformation and lies.

Two of these organizations, Lady Parts Justice & Repro-Action, recently spearheaded campaigns against CPC's in July and October through [exposefakeclinics.com](http://exposefakeclinics.com). During these campaigns, they encouraged their supporters to protest CPC's, review CPC websites to try to find reasons to turn them into the Federal Trade Commission, and to pose as fake clients to try and bait CPC staff or volunteers to say something that could be used against them.

Our hope is that the TRUTH will prevail. We pray that God would use this publicity in a positive way and that people will learn that Pregnancy Medical Clinics, like Pathways, operate under the direction of a Medical Director, with licensed nurses who provide love and support to our clients.
