Campers Favorite Dip

- 1 8 oz package of Cream Cheese
- 1 15 oz. can of Chili with Beans (Hormel's works really well!)
- 2 cups Shredded Cheddar Cheese
- 2 thinly sliced green onions
- 1 tsp Hot Sauce (optional)
- Your favorite Tortilla Chips



Directions

- Spread cream cheese in the bottom of a disposable foil pie pan (spraying with cooking oil first does help keep it from sticking)
- Add Hot Sauce and Onions to Chili. Stir and pour over cream cheese
- Top with cheddar cheese
- Place pan on campfire grate on on the grill. About 5 to 8 minutes until cheese is melted and begins to bubble
- Serve with your favorite tortilla chips

Q: *What is the best remedy for
de-skunking a dog?*

A:

The best recipe uses 1 Quart of Hydrogen Peroxide, ¼ cup baking soda and 1 to 2 tesaspoons of liquid dishwashing soap. Apply to the effected area generously and rub the soapy mixture in. Leave it on for approximately 5 minutes. Rinse thoroughly and, if needed, follow with your regular dog shampoo. Be careful around your fur babies eyes as the peroxide can cause blindness. The process may need to be repeated depending on how direct the hit was.
