Types of data we collect

We collect Personal Data about you, including but not limited to your first name, family name, email address, business or home address, telephone number, and password, when you register in the registration section of our site or otherwise, or place an order for use of our Services.

We log your visits and your usage data when you visit our Site. In particular, we use internet protocol (“IP”) addresses, cookies and similar technologies (e.g., web beacons, pixels, ad tags and device identifiers) to identify you or your device. We receive data from your devices and networks, including location data. When you visit or leave our Site, we receive the URL of both the site you came from and the one you go to next. We also get information about your IP address, proxy server, operating system, web browser and add-ons, device identifier and features, and/or ISP or your mobile carrier. If you use our Site from a mobile device, that device will send us data about your location. Most devices allow you to prevent location data from being sent to us and we respect your settings.

Lawful basis and legitimate interests.

Our Lawful basis for using your personal information is that it is necessary for our legitimate interest of providing you with background check advisory and consulting services.

Who we share information with

We do not share your data with any third parties, but if required by law, we may be obliged to share your personal data with enforcement agencies.

How long do we hold people’s information?
