You might want to include how his situation has affected you or your community, or any changes you have observed in him over time.

Be brief and sincere.
Aim for no more than one page.
Write sincerely from your heart.

4. Conclude with genuine plea for consideration: Express your hope that the Governor will consider the pardon for Ricky

5. **Sign the Letter:** Type your full name if emailing your letter. Write your full name if mailing a handwritten letter.

6. **Review the letter for any errors. Send the letter (preferably in PDF format) to *all three* of the following:**
