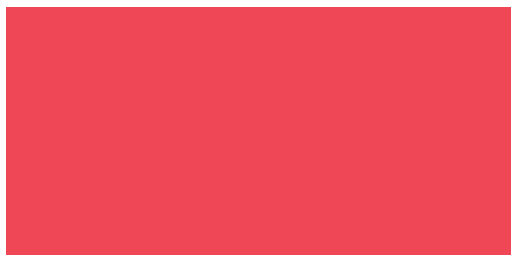

– Ethics Complaint



Mayor Briggs ran a campaign of Ethical Behavior and Financial responsibility. He stated “We will ask you if we can spend your money – every month” – Rumor Letter, April 2017.

Despite such noble campaign promises, he has engaged in political campaigning using city resources since the campaign season has begun. He authorized \$461 of city funds to mail a two page letter to every household in the city (telling citizens to ignore Mr. Darin Clark, not listen to him, as well as providing name recognition to Councilman Kelly) as well as utilizing the city services such as text message, e-mail and voice call out services to promote his two “hand picked” candidates



Ethical behavior is controlled by the Texas Ethics Commission. An officer or employee of a political subdivision is prohibited from spending public funds for political advertising, Section 253.003 of the election code. The Texas Ethics Commission has accepted this case against Mr. Briggs and is now investigating. Councilman Kelly and former Mayor Nylin may also have cases opened against them for willingly accepting the name recognition from Mayor Briggs using public resources.
