EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 1117

ADOPTION & AFFILIATION OF COMMUNITIES

October 12, 2025 — New York, New York

Purpose

To strengthen unity and restore lawful governance among dispersed peoples of African, Aboriginal, and Indigenous descent—along with all those under the jurisdiction and protection of the State of Loc Nation Global Public Benefit Corporation (SoLNGPBC).

Authority

Issued under the authority vested in the Office of the President pursuant to:

- The Restitution Act;
- Executive Orders 1111 through 1116;

- The U.N. Charter, Article 73;
- General Assembly Resolution 1514 (XV) on the Granting of Independence to Colonial Countries and Peoples;
- And the inherent right of self-determination recognized under international and customary law.

Section 1 — Adoption & Affiliation Process

1. A transparent and verifiable process is hereby established for communities, tribes, and organizations to formally affiliate with the State of Loc Nation.
2. Applications for affiliation shall include community constitutions, leadership verification, and commitment to lawful conduct and human rights principles.
3. Each affiliation shall be recorded within the Registry of Adopted and Affiliated Communities (RAAC) maintained by the Treasury and Office of the Ombudsperson.

Section 2 — Lawful Character & Conduct

1. All affiliates must demonstrate lawful character, non-violence, and respect for human rights.
2. Affiliates must operate in good faith under the Community Code of Conduct, which prohibits exploitation, discrimination, and abuse of power.
3. Violations shall be investigated by the Office of the Ombudsperson or Ethics Council, and corrective or disciplinary actions shall be taken as necessary to preserve justice and integrity.

Section 3 — Mental Health and Trauma-Informed Governance

1. Recognizing that many citizens continue to experience historical and inter-generational trauma, each affiliated community shall incorporate trauma-informed support systems into its governance and social programs.
2. The Office of Mental Health and Healing within the State of Loc Nation shall provide assistance, training, and guidance to local leadership in these matters.

Section 4 — Circulation of the Loc Nation Dollar (LND)

1. All adopted and affiliated communities are authorized and encouraged to utilize the Loc Nation Dollar (LND) as their lawful medium of exchange, accounting, and restitutorial currency, as established under Executive Order 1111 and 1116.

2. Treasury guidance for currency circulation, reporting, and parity accounting shall be provided through the Restitution Payment Certificate (RPC) and Community Ledger Framework.

Section 5 — Non-Liability and Sovereign Protection

1. The State of Loc Nation assumes no liability for internal misconduct by affiliated entities that deviate from lawful character, ethics, or restorative conduct.
2. Each community's adherence to the Code of Conduct and Non-Liability Agreement preserves its standing within the Alliance.
3. Communities found violating human rights, engaging in unlawful activity, or promoting violence shall be suspended or expelled pending investigation.

Section 6 — Establishment of the Loc Nation United Nations (L-UN)

The State of Loc Nation hereby affirms the establishment of the Loc Nation United Nations (L-UN)—a coalition of self-determined communities and affiliated governments of African, Indigenous, and Original descent—operating under Articles 73 and 1514 of the U.N. Charter.

This alliance mirrors the spirit and structure of the global United Nations, serving as a lawful forum for peace, restitution, and cooperative development among the peoples it represents.

Section 7 — Implementation


1. The Office of the President, the Treasury, and the Office of the Ombudsperson shall coordinate to register, certify, and publicly record each affiliation in the Official Journal of the State of Loc Nation.
2. Affiliations shall take effect upon issuance of a Community Adoption Certificate, signed by the President and sealed by the Treasury.
3. This Order is effective immediately and shall be implemented without delay.
