My life's work sits at the intersection of faith, service, and accountability. I believe leadership begins with responsibility — to God, to family, and to the people we are called to serve. As a mentor and community healer, I have worked directly with individuals and families impacted by long-standing economic and systemic barriers, helping translate hardship into structure, support, and opportunity.

My focus is not division, but restoration; not rhetoric, but results. First key message

Established LND, the official Black dollar. I have authored and advanced an economic framework referred to as LND, which is designed to address gaps in access to capital and economic participation within historically excluded communities. This work focuses on creating lawful, documented models for community-based economic restoration and financial accountability. The framework has been presented through written materials, public documentation, and related records.

Second key message

Solved the 400 yr restitution. DC 1:24 cv 00479RC My work addresses long-standing historical and economic inequities through a structured restitution framework that translates historical harm into policy-oriented solutions. Rather than focusing on protest or rhetoric, my approach emphasizes documentation, lawful structure, and implementation models intended to support accountability, restoration, and long-term economic stability.

Third key message

The framer of completed federalist papers. Library of Congress Control Number (LCCN): 2025922369 I have authored and published constitutional scholarship engaging with foundational governance principles, including analysis and completion-oriented work related to the Federalist Papers. This scholarship focuses on civic education, constitutional interpretation, and public understanding of federal structure and accountability. Related materials have been documented and made publicly accessible.

I care most about policies that help people and communities become economically stable, self-sufficient, and treated fairly under the law. This includes creating access to jobs, capital, and opportunity, especially for communities that have been left out for generations.

I am also passionate about constitutional governance, civic education, and ethical leadership, so people understand how government works and leaders are held accountable.

At the core, my policy focus is on strengthening families, stabilizing communities, and making sure solutions are practical, lawful, and long-lasting as my research will support.
