This Cookie Policy explains how HB Partners Limited ("we", "us", "our") uses cookies and similar technologies on hbpartners.uk. It should be read alongside the company's Privacy Notice.

The website currently displays a cookie notice stating that cookies are used to analyse website traffic and optimise website experience. This policy explains those uses in more detail.

1. What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files placed on your device when you visit a website. They help websites function properly, remember preferences, improve security, and provide information about how visitors use the site.

Cookies can be session cookies, which expire when you close your browser, or persistent cookies, which stay on your device for a set period or until deleted.

2. How we use cookies

We use cookies and similar technologies to:

- operate and maintain the website
- understand how visitors use the site
- improve website performance and user experience
- remember preferences where applicable
- support security and reliability

Where analytics cookies are used, the information is typically aggregated to help us understand overall usage trends and improve the website experience.

3. Categories of cookies we may use

Strictly necessary cookies

These are essential for core website functions such as page navigation, security, network management, and remembering your cookie choices.

Analytics and performance cookies

These help us understand how visitors interact with the website, including which pages are visited most often and how users move through the site.

Functional cookies

These may be used to remember preferences and improve the way the website works for returning visitors.

Third-party cookies

Some hosting, embedded content, analytics, or technical services may place cookies through the website. Those third parties control their own cookies and related processing.

4. Consent

When you first visit the website, you may be presented with a cookie banner. This gives you the opportunity to accept cookies used on the website.

You can also control cookies through your browser settings. Disabling some cookies may affect how the website functions or how certain features are delivered.

5. Managing cookies

Most browsers allow you to review, block, or delete cookies. You can usually do this through the browser settings or privacy controls menu.

You may choose to block all cookies, block cookies from specific websites, delete stored cookies, or clear cookies automatically when you close your browser.

6. Third-party services

The website may rely on third-party providers for services such as website hosting, analytics, embedded media, or other technical functions. Where those services set cookies, their own privacy and cookie terms will also apply.

Because third-party cookies are controlled by the relevant provider, you should review the relevant provider policies for more detailed information about how those cookies work.
