

NON-NEGOTIABLE CONDITIONS: PRE-CHARTERING MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS

1. **Corporate Validity:** Copy of Certificate of Incorporation (Charterer & Intermediary).
2. **Formal Authorization:** Original Mandate Letter (stating the scope of authority).
3. **KYC/CIS:** Fully signed CIS for both the Charterer and the Intermediary.
4. **Financial Proof:** Bank Comfort Letter (BCL) showing liquid funds sufficient for the chartering operation (Charterer & Intermediary).
5. **Operation Scope:** Written confirmation of the intended route, cargo type, and estimated Laycan dates.
6. **Contractual Readiness:** Written acknowledgment that the Charterer accepts our standard Charter Party terms.
7. **Direct Communication:** Written consent for direct due diligence contact with the Charterer prior to contract execution.
8. **Liability and Indemnity Statement:** A formal declaration signed by the Intermediary, accepting full joint and several liability for any damages arising from the Charterer's default, non-performance, or disappearance, in the event that the due diligence provided by the Intermediary (KYC/CIS) is proven to be false, inaccurate, or negligent.
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!! Note: Any intermediary failing to provide these documents or operating without a registered corporate entity will be automatically rejected. No exceptions. We do not release any vessel particulars until these requirements are met in full. !!

Performance Security: In accordance with MOL Group policy, providing the vessel for service requires a 'Performance Security' to cover initial operational costs. This amount will be fully credited and deducted from the first hire payment installment. Please be advised that this is a mandatory requirement for all our chartering operations and is non-negotiable.

Please be informed that MOL Group exclusively enters into chartering agreements with partners who are capable of providing the required 'Performance Security.' Should the charterer you represent be unwilling or unable to meet this standard, we will be unable to proceed with this business opportunity due to our internal risk management policies.
