



SVAXECO League Rules

- Winter League begins January 16th, 2022. Late entries are available until January 30th, 2022. League nights are Sundays from 5pm to completion of games.
- Entry fee is \$80 per thrower for season.
- Competitors may bring their own personal axe, or utilize axes available at SVAXECO. Handles may not be longer than 24" from head to base.
- 16-32 players sign up (If more than 32 register, lowest win/point values eliminated from tournament at end of season).
- 8-week Grid season, Season Tournament on Week 9.
- 4 Matches per person, per night.
- Matches are Best 2 of 3, all match points and wins kept for record for Major placement and elimination.
- In event of win/point tie (if more than 32 players register), sudden death matches will take place before tournament (TBD).
- A 1 week absence will be recorded as an automatic forfeit, and 0 points will be awarded.
- A 2 week absence (without notification) will forfeit your season, and entry fee. (Entry fee may be partially refunded if notified, depending on time frame of season)
- WATL rules will apply to all matches, and judges will be on a rotational basis, selected from SVAXCO staff.
- Top 3 competitors will receive a cash prize at the end of the season, based on number of entries.

Game Rules

- Games are based on highest score of 10 throws.
- Matches are completed when a competitor wins 2 games.
- Throws will be judged on majority of axe blade.
- Bullseyes and Killshots will be based on axe blade entering the paint of the targets. If the blade 'breaks the paint', the appropriate points will be awarded.
- Killshots are only open on competitor's 5th and 10th throw of the game. Killshots must be called, and the blade must land in the paint. Landing anywhere outside the killshots, or falling from the target will result in a score of zero for that throw.
- During games after each competitor's 5th throw, competitors will swap lanes, in order to prevent board bias.
- Scores from games will be kept for records in order to break ties. In the event of ties at the end of the season, the competitor with the highest scores from the season will be placed at a higher seed for the tournament.
- If a competitor feels a board needs to be replaced, they may request a board change. Board change is ultimately up to the judge and/or SVAXECO personnel, and a time out will be imposed if the board requires changing.
