
# OPERATIONS

East Dundee Fire District (EDFD) responded to **166** incidents during May 2022, with a total of **263** apparatus responses, spending **162** hours and **30** minutes of time.

The ratio of EMS incidents to Fire incidents was **55%** to **45%**, respectively. Total Fire related calls for May were **74**. EMS related calls for the month were **92**, including a total of **77** patients treated, with **54** of those transported to area hospitals. COVID-19 was suspected or confirmed in **2** patients.

Overlapping calls (at least one other call at the same time) represents approximately **38%** (**63** incidents) of the total call volume (**166** incidents).

For the month of May, EDFD averaged **2.39** Fire calls per day and **2.97** EMS calls per day for an overall daily average of **5.35** calls per day which is an increase of **26%** over the same period last year.





PROVIDER IMPRESSIONS ON EMS INCIDENTS  
May 2022 - 77 Patients




MAY 2022 - 8 MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENTS






