
OPERATIONS

East Dundee Fire District (EDFD) responded to **168** incidents during July 2022, with a total of **290** apparatus responses, spending **192** hours and **37** minutes of time. **89** calls were during the hours of 6 AM to 6 PM and the other **79** were during the hours from 6 PM to 6 AM.

The ratio of EMS incidents to Fire incidents was **58%** to **42%**, respectively. There was a total of **70** Fire related calls for July. EMS related calls for the month were **98**, including a total of **91** patients treated, with **55** of those transported to area hospitals. COVID-19 was suspected or confirmed in **2** patients.

Overlapping calls (at least one other call at the same time) represents approximately **28%** (**47** incidents) of the total call volume (**168** incidents). Out of that total, there were **25** overlapping incidents (**15%**) that occurred within the EDFD district.

For the month of July, EDFD averaged **2.26** Fire calls per day and **3.16** EMS calls per day for an overall daily average of **5.42** calls per day which is an increase of **8%** over the same period last year.




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



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


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

PROVIDER IMPRESSIONS ON EMS INCIDENTS
July 2022 - 91 Patients






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
JULY 2022 - OVERLAPPING INCIDENTS 168 Incidents with 47 Overlapping (28%)


