

**ORDINANCE NO. 2022-01**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE EAST DUNDEE AND COUNTRYSIDE  
FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT ORDINANCE #2021-O2  
(CHARGES FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES)**

**WHEREAS**, the East Dundee and Countryside Fire Protection District (the “District”), is a fire protection district duly organized under the laws of the State of Illinois; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of the District has full power to pass all necessary ordinances, and rules and regulations for the proper management and conduct of the business of the Board of Trustees of the District for carrying into effect the objects for which the District was formed under 70 ILCS 705/6; and

**WHEREAS**, on February 16, 2021, the Board of Trustees adopted its Ordinance 2021-O2 entitled “An Ordinance Establishing a Schedule of Charges and Assessing Fees for Emergency Medical Services by the East Dundee and Countryside Fire Protection District”.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of Trustees of the East Dundee and Countryside Fire Protection District, Kane and Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

**Section One:** The Board of Trustees hereby amends its Ordinance 2021-O2 by amending the fee schedule for Residents and Non-District residents to read as follows:

<b>BLS Emergency w/ Transport</b>	<b>\$</b>	<b>4460.00</b>
<b>ALS Emergency w/ Transport</b>	<b>\$</b>	<b>4543.00</b>
<b>Transport cost Per Mile</b>	<b>\$</b>	<b>25.00</b>
<b>Treatment No Transport ALS or BLS</b>	<b>\$</b>	<b>1000.00</b>

**Section Three:** All revenue from the charges assessed pursuant to this Ordinance shall be deposited in the Ambulance Fund of the East Dundee and Countryside Fire Protection District.

**Section Four:** The Fire Chief may, in his discretion, waive the costs and/or fees due under this ordinance in whole or in part.

**Section Five:** Nothing in this Ordinance shall authorize the District to refuse to provide any service to any person, business or entity that has not paid for services previously provided or that owes any money for services previously provided.


**Section Six:** That the provisions of this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect as of January 18<sup>th</sup>, 2022.

**Section Seven:** That this Ordinance shall supersede any ordinances, resolutions or motions or parts of ordinances, resolutions, or motions in conflict with any part herein, and any such ordinances, resolutions, or motions or parts of such are hereby repealed to the extent of any conflict.

**Section Eight:** If any section, paragraph, or provisions of this Ordinance shall be held invalid or unenforceable for any reason, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.
