

ORDINANCE NO. 2020-03

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE EAST DUNDEE AND COUNTRYSIDE
FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT ORDINANCE #2019-04
(CHARGES FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES)**

WHEREAS, the East Dundee and Countryside Fire Protection District (the "District"), is a fire protection district duly organized under the laws of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the District has full power to pass all necessary ordinances, and rules and regulations for the proper management and conduct of the business of the Board of Trustees of the District for carrying into effect the objects for which the District was formed under 70 ILCS 705/6; and

WHEREAS, on April 15, 2019, the Board of Trustees adopted its Ordinance 2019-04 entitled "An Ordinance Establishing a Schedule of Charges and Assessing Fees for Emergency Medical Services by the East Dundee and Countryside Fire Protection District".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the East Dundee and Countryside Fire Protection District, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section One: The Board of Trustees hereby amends its Ordinance 2019-04 by amending the fee schedule for Non-District residents to read as follows:

Non-District Residents

ALS Emergency w/ Transport	\$	3,600.00
BLS Emergency w/ Transport	\$	2,900.00
Treatment Non/Transport	\$	400.00
Mileage per Mile	\$	15.00

Section Two: The Board of Trustees hereby amends its Ordinance 2019-04 by amending the fee schedule for District residents to read as follows:

District Residents

ALS Emergency w/ Transport	\$	3,600.00
BLS Emergency w/ Transport	\$	2,900.00
Treatment Non/Transport	\$	400.00
Mileage per Mile	\$	15.00

Section Three: All revenue from the charges assessed pursuant to this Ordinance shall be deposited in the Ambulance Fund of the East Dundee and Countryside Fire Protection District.

Section Four: The Fire Chief may, in his discretion, waive the costs and/or fees due under this ordinance in whole or in part.

Section Five: Nothing in this Ordinance shall authorize the District to refuse to provide any service to any person, business or entity that has not paid for services previously provided or that owes any money for services previously provided.

Section Six: When emergency medical services are requested of the District but do not involve a transport by the District, a service fee shall be charged according to the above fee schedule.

Section Seven: That the provisions of this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect as of June 16, 2020.

Section Seven: That this Ordinance shall supersede any ordinances, resolutions or motions or parts of ordinances, resolutions or motions in conflict with any part herein, and any such ordinances, resolutions, or motions or parts of such are hereby repealed to the extent of any conflict.

Section Eight: If any section, paragraph or provisions of this Ordinance shall be held invalid or unenforceable for any reason, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.


