PROGRAM: July program chair Karen Goedde introduced Vicki Quisenberry, Executive Director of the Daviess County Public Schools Foundation, as program speaker. Vicki provided a statistical snapshot of the Daviess County Schools – 11,800 students, 67% on free and reduced lunch, 2,200 employees. She described her role at the Foundation as that of a connection broker, raising money for at risk students by matching people with their passion. A recent project resulting from such a connection is a fundraiser featuring a sneak preview of the film "Black in Blue," a documentary by award winning filmmaker Paul Wagner about the four athletes who broke the race barrier at the University of Kentucky. Vicki explained that the idea for the fundraiser originated with members of the Daviess County High School Class of 1967 and their desire to honor a classmate, Houston Hogg, who happens to be one of these athletes.

Vicki said the event will take place Saturday, July 28 at RiverPark Center. Jagoe Homes and Owensboro Health are title sponsors. The evening includes a VIP reception at 5:00pm, dinner at 6:00pm and movie screening at 7:30pm. Tickets are available at OwensboroTickets.com or from the Foundation.
