FELLOWSHIP REPORT: Greg reported 29 members and 8 Honor Flight guests in attendance. **David Fort** introduced his parents, Bessie and Earl Fort, as his guests.

NEW MEMBER INDUCTION: **Tish Correa-Osborne** introduced new member **Dana Peveler**, Executive Director of the Munday Activity Center. **President Scott Williams** presented Dana with her Rotary pin and **Jeff Ebelhar** explained the responsibilities of Rotary membership.

PROGRAM: **Keith Cain** kicked off the Honor Flight Luncheon program by expressing appreciation to the club for its involvement in and support of Honor Flight. He thanked **Bill Barron** in particular for first bringing Honor Flight to the club's attention. Keith continued with a very special thank you to the WWII veterans who participated in the most recent flight, commenting that they are indeed the "greatest generation" to whom we owe more than we can ever repay. Daviess County Sheriff's Deputy **Matt Ralph** next shared an inspirational moment from his experience serving as a Guardian on the flight to a 96-year old WWII Marine veteran.

Barbara Poynter then described the itinerary of the special 4-day WWII flight, accompanying her remarks with a slideshow of photos. A total of 61 veterans from Kentucky participated in the flight, including seven from the Owensboro area. Barbara introduced the four veterans who were present: Arthur Baird, Ray Kramer, Tommy Wieder and Richard Dyche (*see photos below*). Each spoke briefly about their Honor Flight experience. Barbara reported that the next flight will take place on September 11-13 and will include a number of Korean War veterans.



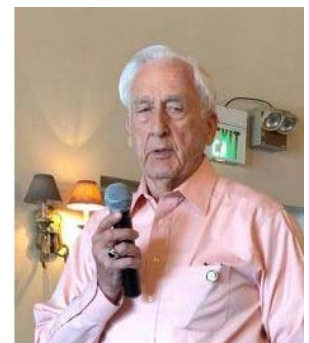
