American rivers are a critical economic and recreational resource that need the protection of the communities they touch. ***A River Runs Through It*** is a bold collaborative program of Rotary Clubs, youth-driven Interact Clubs, the American Queen Steamboat Company, and river cities to address the sweeping environmental issues that negatively impact the Ohio and Mississippi Rivers. During an eight-day river cruise, the American Duchess, a 166-passenger steamboat, will visit these ports where Rotary Clubs will lead environmental service projects alongside students from high school Interact Clubs and community members:
