#### **REMEMBRANCE**

It is with a heavy heart that we announce the passing of one of our valued colleagues, Jerry Kanter, who passed away suddenly on January 23, 2023. Jerry was a cherished member of our H.C. Peck & Associates team since 2012, and his daily presence brought joy to our lives for more than a decade.

Prior to joining Peck, Jerry enjoyed a very productive 20-year career with The City and County of Denver's Department of Aviation where his responsibilities included airport land acquisition, development, lease negotiations, and the disposition of off-site airport parcels.



Arguably, Jerry's most remarkable achievement was his role as Coordinator of Property Acquisition for the Denver International Airport, in which he was responsible for the acquisition of all the land needed for DIA's site, comprised of approximately 53 square miles. His duties in this effort included coordinating the activities of title company examiners and closers, appraisers, water and mineral experts and staff, as well as interfacing with land surveyors, engineers, attorneys, relocation consultants, landowners and public officials. Jerry successfully negotiated over 75 transactions totaling over \$10 million while managing 45 single-family homes, disposing of 135 mobile homes, marketing buildings for lease, and relocating two microwave towers. This position required detailed knowledge of real estate law and practice, the appraisal process, including damages and benefits, and Federal and State statutes regarding the acquisition and condemnation of real property.

Jerry was not only an exemplary Right of Way professional, and he was also a truly good person - and one whom will be deeply missed by his colleagues, his clients and his friends. We will always remember him for his hard work, dedication, and jolly spirit.

Jerry is survived by his two brothers, Bob Kanter and Bruce Kanter, and their families.

Rest in peace, Jerry.
