M74 is famous for its beautiful spiral arms, which led to its nickname, the Phantom Galaxy. It is approximately 32 million light-years away from Earth. The galaxy has a face-on orientation, meaning that we see it directly from the side, providing an excellent view of its structure.M74 is considered a grand design spiral galaxy, meaning it has well-defined, tightly wound spiral arms. It is relatively large, with a diameter of about 95,000 light-years, making it slightly smaller than our Milky Way galaxy.


