



FRONT LOAD BIN GUIDELINES



Thank you for choosing Integrated as your waste collection service provider!

To help us both out, we have compiled some general guidelines in regards to your bin:

BIN PLACEMENT

- Please ensure that your bin stays in the same location as when it is delivered to you, as this will ensure that our operator will be able to access your bin on pickup days.

ACCESS TO BIN

- Please make sure that no vehicles, equipment, or RV's are blocking access to your bin on your scheduled pickup day.
- If you have gates, please ensure that they are open on your scheduled pickup day so that we can access your bin.
- Minimum clearance around the bin should be 6 feet please.
- Please ensure that your driveway is passable so that we can access your bin year round. (snow cleared, etc.)
- Pickup times can vary. (Weather, traffic, etc.)

CARE & MAINTENANCE OF BIN

- Please DO NOT put burn barrel ashes, clay / dirt, concrete, rocks, shingles, drywall, paint, hazardous waste, oil, appliances, metals or tires in your bin. We recommend bagging your grass clippings. Please do not place items on top of your bin lid as this will make a mess when the garbage truck dumps your bin.
- Please do not place extra garbage in front of your bin, as it won't be picked up manually.
- Please do not overfill your bin as items could fallout when the garbage truck collects your bin to dump. We do not want to leave a mess for you, so please ensure that your bin lids close and sit flush to the bin.
