Whale, Hello There! Whale & Dolphin watching

15 minutes away

Watch fishermen unload their catch at the lively harbor before setting sail on a double-decker boat. Spot dolphins, blue whales, and humpbacks along Sri Lanka's coast, with top locations like Dondra Point, Galle, Hikkaduwa, and Mirissa.

Stilt Fishing

22 minutes away

Relive the magic of Madol Duva

23 minutes away

A serene island nestled in the lush waters of the Koggala Lake, known for its natural beauty and literary fame. Discover tranquil surroundings, peaceful boat rides, and the island's connection to Sri Lanka's beloved novel, "Madol Duwa."





Museum of Martin Wickremasinghe

24 minutes away

Explore the life and works of Sri Lanka's literary icon. Immerse yourself in the rich cultural heritage through his personal artifacts, manuscripts, and a deeper understanding of his contributions to Sri Lankan literature.

Unveil the charm of Matara

30 minutes away

Explore Matara Fort, a historic site shaped by Portuguese and Dutch influence. Visit the Weherahena Underground Temple, Wewurukannala Temple, and the lighthouse before ending your tour with a breathtaking sunset at Polhena Beach.



Indulge in the flavours of Ceylon Tea

30 minutes away

Explore the Hadungoda Tea Estate, where you'll discover the modern process of tea production. Tour the plantations, learn about the techniques used, and enjoy a fresh cup of Ceylon tea with stunning views.

Jungle Beach

45 minutes away

A hidden paradise where lush greenery meets crystal-clear waters. Tucked away in a tranquil cove, it's the perfect spot for relaxation, swimming, and snorkeling amidst nature's beauty.





Japanese Peace Pagoda

49 minutes away

The Japanese Peace Pagoda, also known as Rumassala White Temple, is a tranquil sanctuary nestled amidst lush greenery. Offering panoramic views of the coastline, this serene temple symbolizes hope, harmony, and peace. Its peaceful atmosphere makes it the perfect spot for reflection, spirituality, and soaking in the natural beauty that surrounds it.

Village Walk Wakwella

55 minutes away

Immerse yourself in the charm of rural Sri Lanka with a peaceful walk through the Wakwella village. Experience traditional village life, explore lush landscapes, and interact with friendly locals, offering a glimpse into the island's rich cultural heritage.



Uncover the Wonders of GALLE!

56 minutes away

Experience the best of Sri Lanka's southern coast- witness the unique tradition of stilt fishing in Galle, explore its colonial charm, and visit Ambalangoda's moonstone mines and mask factory. Discover the Koggala Turtle Hatchery, step into history at the iconic Galle Fort, and learn about Martin Wickramasinghe's remarkable legacy.

HALF DAY TOUR OF GALLE

Experience the charm of Sri Lanka's south coast- watch stilt fishermen in Mirissa, visit the Martin Wickramasinghe House in Koggala, and explore the historic Galle Fort before returning to Weligama.

Discover the Winged Wonders of KALMETIYA

1 hour 10 minutes away

Located between Tangalle and Hambantota, Kalmetiya Bird Sanctuary offers a tranquil birdwatching experience away from the crowds. Accessible via Hungama, it features coastal lagoons, mangroves, and grassy plains teeming with bird and marine life. Originally declared a sanctuary in 1938 and reestablished in 1984, it remains a haven for nature lovers. End your visit with a stroll along Tangalle Beach.





Kanneliya Rain Forest

1 hour 20 minutes away

Explore the Kanneliya Forest Reserve in Galle, one of the world's most biodiverse regions, surpassing even the famous Sinharaja Forest. Once recovering from selective logging in the 1970s, the forest now thrives, with rejuvenated water flows and streams enhancing its lush vegetation and hilly terrain.

Admire the stunning natural cascades and crystal-clear waters, perfect for a refreshing dip. Discover waterfalls and immerse yourself in the beauty of this unique natural wonder.

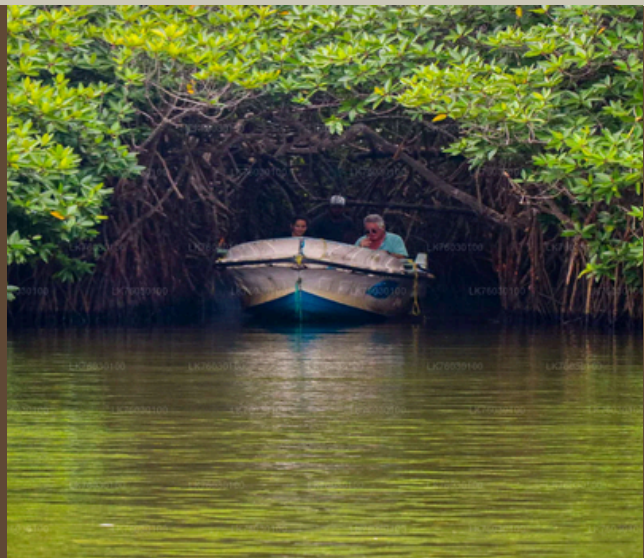
Boat ride Adventure Madhu River

1 hour 25 minutes away

Embark on a magical speedboat ride down the Madu River, a 900-hectare wetland estuary with 64 islands.

Glide through pristine mangrove forests, rich in biodiversity, and protected as a World Heritage site.

Explore the unique ecosystem, enjoy a refreshing King Coconut drink, visit a Buddhist Monastery, and witness Kraal fishing and cinnamon peeling. End the day with a fish therapy experience and lantern-lit fishing traps at dusk.



Embark on an Elephant Adventure Udawalawe!

1 hour 50 minutes away

Udawalawe National Park, 107 km from Weligama, is Sri Lanka's sixth-largest sanctuary, spanning 30,821 hectares. Established in 1972, it's a top spot for wild Asian elephant sightings, with around 500 elephants roaming in herds. The park is also home to water buffalo, deer, jackals, and elusive leopards. Explore the Udawalawe Reservoir and visit the Elephant Orphanage for a complete wildlife experience.

Into the Wild, Yala Safari Awaits!

2 hours away

Journey through Sri Lanka's most famous wildlife park, home to leopards, elephants, and diverse flora and fauna. Explore Yala's vast landscapes on a thrilling jeep safari, with the option to visit Tangalle Beach and Dikwella Blowhole along the way. Return to Weligama by late evening.





Venture into magic Sinharaja Rain Forest

2 hours 20 minutes away

Sinharaja Rainforest, a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1989, is a biodiverse treasure accessible only on foot. Guided tours reveal its rich flora and fauna, with tickets available at Kudawa and Deodawa offices.

Spanning 189 sq km, it plays a crucial role in Sri Lanka's ecosystem, replenishing soil and water resources. Once a royal reserve, it may have been the last refuge of the Sri Lankan lion. End your visit with lunch at a local restaurant before heading back.

Elephant Orphanage Pinnawala

4 hours away

On this full-day tour, visit the Pinnawala Elephant Orphanage to witness a large herd of Asian elephants. Established in 1975, it now cares for over 70 elephants. Learn about conservation efforts, watch feeding sessions, and see the herd enjoy their daily river bath—a truly unforgettable experience.



White Water Rafting Kithulgala

4 hours 10 minutes away

Experience an adventurous getaway in Kithulgala, offering white water rafting, jungle walks, bird watching, and river bathing. Nestled in the jungle, it's the perfect destination for adventure and leisure close to Colombo.

Enjoy the stunning scenery, take a refreshing swim, embark on thrilling white water rafting, or go trekking through the rainforest.
