

Storm-Ready Roof Checklist

Exterior Roof Condition
 ☐ Inspection of roofing materials (EPDM, TPO, PVC, metal, etc.) ☐ Identification of cracks, blisters, punctures, or ponding water ☐ Check for loose or missing flashing and fasteners ☐ Evaluation of membrane seams and adhesion
Drainage System
 □ Clear gutters, downspouts, and drains of debris □ Ensure proper water flow and identify standing water □ Check for clogged or damaged drainage components
Interior Inspection
 □ Look for water stains, mold, or leaks inside the building □ Assess insulation for moisture damage □ Inspect ceiling and walls for structural integrity
Flashing and Seals
☐ Check around vents, HVAC units, skylights, and chimneys☐ Ensure proper sealing of penetrations to prevent leaks
Roof Deck and Structural Integrity
 Inspect for sagging or weak spots in the roof deck Evaluate load-bearing capacity Identify signs of corrosion, rust, or rot
Energy Efficiency & Insulation
☐ Check insulation levels and effectiveness☐ Assess reflective coatings or energy-saving measures

Recommended Inspection Frequency

- Twice a Year Ideally in spring and fall
- After Severe Weather Storms, heavy rain, or high winds
- Before and After Major Roof Work
