Heifer Show

***Purebreds must be registered with papers. Purebreds of 7/8 or greater are eligible to show in this division.**

Percentage cattle less than 7/8 (paper or not) will show in the commercial female classes.

Purebred Heifer Entries

1. Paper and tattoo will be checked
2. Breed Classes (minimum of 5 head entered to make a breed class, if that is not met, they will be placed in Other Breeds)
3. Champion and Reserve Breed winners compete for Grand Champion Purebred Heifer
4. Champion and Reserve Purebred Heifer receive Trophy Buckles & Scholarship and Grand Champion will compete for Overall Champion Female

Commercial Heifer Entries

1. Divided into Division Classes by age
2. Champion and Reserve in Junior, Intermediate and Senior Divisions compete for overall Commercial Female
3. Champion and Reserve Commercial Heifer receive Trophy Buckles & Scholarship and Grand Champion will compete for Overall Champion Female

Overall Female

1. Champion Purebred and Champion Commercial Female will compete for Overall Female
2. Overall, Champion Female will receive a Championship Buckle

Steer Show

1. Classes split by Weight, Shown from Lightest to Heaviest
2. Champion and Reserve Receive Trophy Buckles & Scholarship

Showmanship

Automatic Entry for each Participant.

Showmanship is judged throughout the entire show. The Showmanship judges will be evaluating the participants during the day and a short list will be posted following the confirmation show, the short list will be the participants chosen for the showmanship finals in Junior, Intermediate and Senior age divisions.

Ages: as of January 1, 2026

Peewee – 8 & under

Peewee participants all participate in their own Peewee Showmanship Class for Champion and Reserve Showman to win Trophy Buckles

Junior – 9-12

Intermediate – 13-15 Trophy Buckles and Scholarships will be awarded to each age category Champion and Reserve Showman

Senior – 16-21



General Rules and Regulations

1. ***This is a FAMILY EVENT. The objective is to work together as a family and help your children when necessary. WE STRONGLY ENCOURAGE only juniors doing the grooming/fitting of their animals. If they need help by all means help them, but we discourage adults doing everything for them. This event is learning opportunity for youth.***
2. The Lazy RC Ranch Ltd.; Russ and Cindy Sibbald and the Cody Sibbald Legacy Classic Committee are not responsible for any accident, injury or damage suffered to person or property while at the show and grounds. Participants and their exhibits enter the show "at their own risk".
3. **Only MAILED entries will be accepted with cheque or cash payment option.**
4. Livestock on the grounds must have a CCIA tag.
5. Show is open to ages 21 and under, as of January 1, 2026.
6. Purebred papers and tattoo will be checked.
7. ***Purebreds must be registered with papers. Purebreds of 7/8 or greater are eligible to show in this division. Percentage cattle less than 7/8 (paper or not) will show in the commercial female classes.**
8. Cattle may only be shown in one division.
9. No animals with ringworm or any other contagious diseases will be allowed on the grounds.
10. If you require power, please bring a generator.
11. All Steers and Heifers must be born in 2025 and must be halter broke.
12. No animal shall be considered by the judge in awarding of prizes unless the exhibitors show number is conspicuously displayed.
13. No tampering or altering livestock in any way will be tolerated.
14. Purebred classes will follow breed specific rules. Purebred animal entries must be accompanied by a purebred registration paper. All registration papers must be in the participants names or family name. Registered percentage females less than 7/8 can ONLY be entered in the commercial heifer show.
15. All rules and complaints will be left to the discretion of the show committee to make the final decision.
16. The show is open to all but the committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.
