Encourage peers to focus on their strengths, use natural supports, develop their own recovery goals, and strengthen their valued roles within the community.

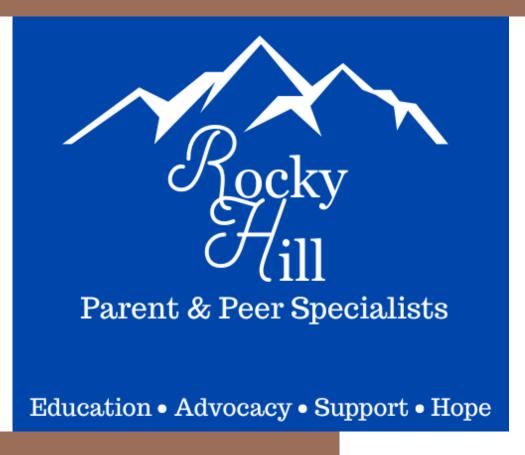
