

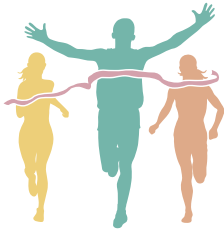
Schedule of Events

COMMUNITY FITNESS 5K & FUN RUN

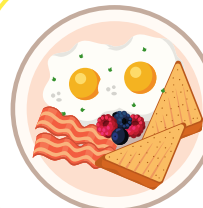
