

2 CHRONICLES 14 2 Chronicles 14:11

"Then Asa cried out to the LORD his God, "O LORD, no one but you can help the powerless against the mighty! Help us, O LORD our God, for we trust in you alone. It is in your name that we have come against this vast horde. O LORD, you are our God; do not let mere men prevail against you!" King Asa did what was both pleasing and good in the sight of God in his leadership. He removed altars and shrines dedicated to false gods, and he commanded the people to worship only the LORD, and to only obey his laws and commands.

But notice here in V.11 the very short prayer that he prays, it's nothing flashy, and it's only one verse long. It's coming from a heart that is truly seeking the LORD with complete faith in the LORD. As a had done all that God wanted him to do in his leadership, so he then goes to the LORD in prayer, acknowledging that they trust in him alone and they expect the LORD to give them victory. As a didn't put limitations on what God could do in his prayer, nor did he feel like he had to pray a super long prayer to the LORD in order to try and get his attention. He knew that God was listening to his prayers, and he knew the power of God, so he just left his prayers request with the LORD and kept on living in God's will. This is what we need in our life, this sense of obedience and reverence for God that comes from a personal relationship with God, where we just send up a simple prayer to the LORD, knowing that he is our Father and he will do what is best.
